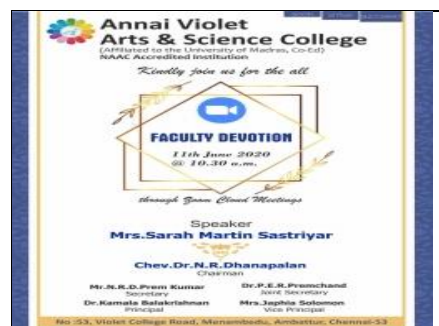

As the first event for this academic year 2020-21, “Faculty



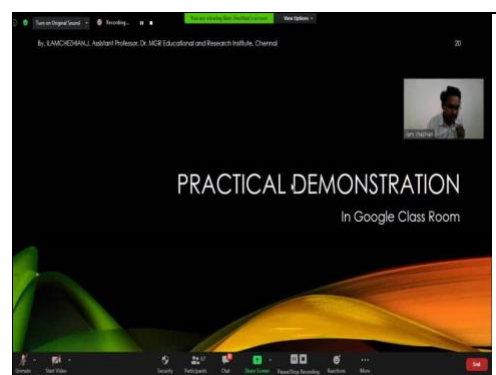

NAAC PEER TEAM VISIT

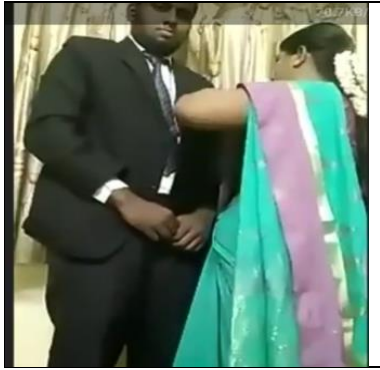

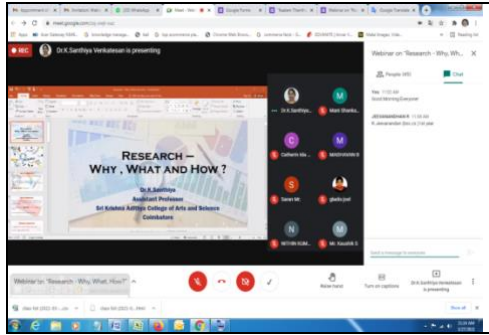
WEBINAR

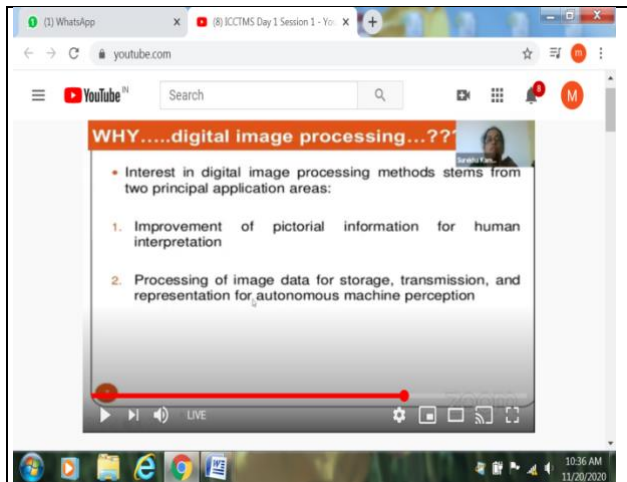

INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE

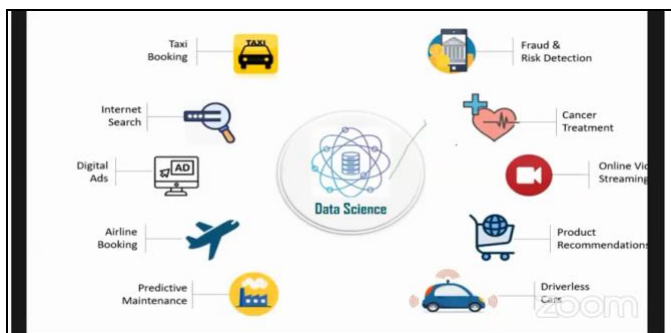
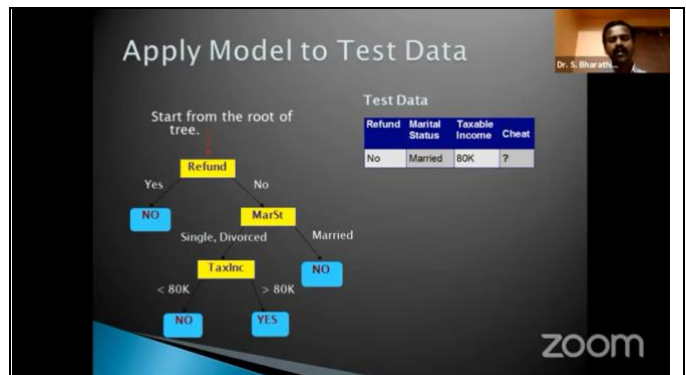

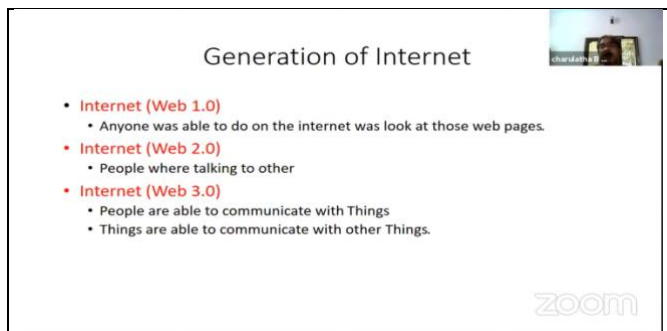
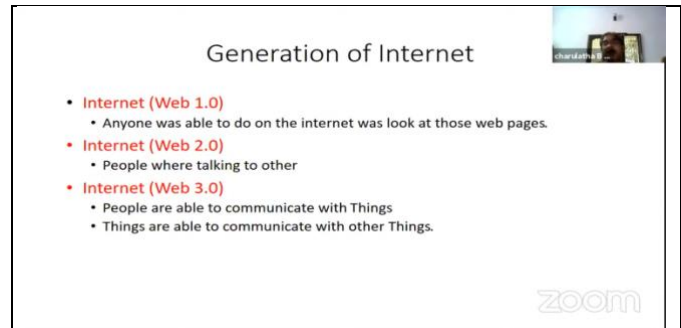
WEBINAR

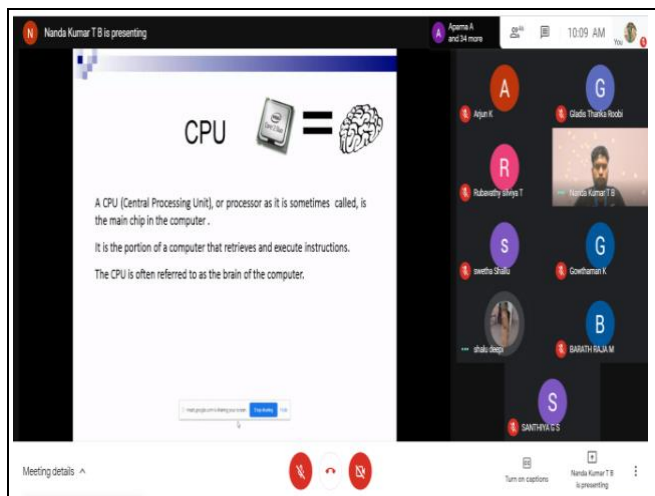

Fellow, Department of Chemistry Jackson State University, USA.

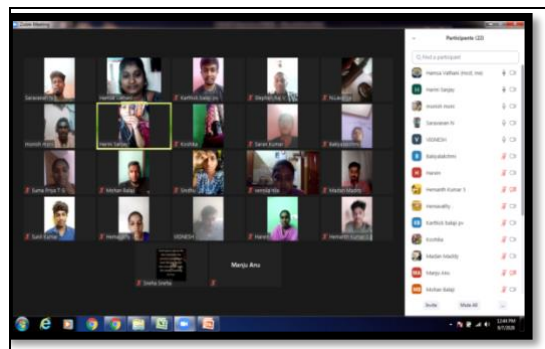
POSTER PRESENTATION

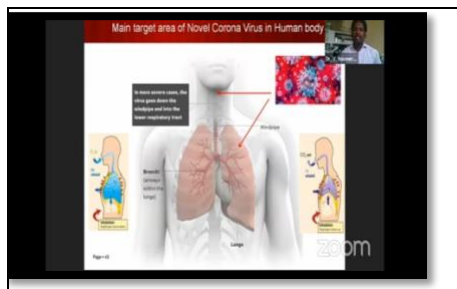


WEBINAR ON A GLIMPSE OF FORENSIC SCIENCE

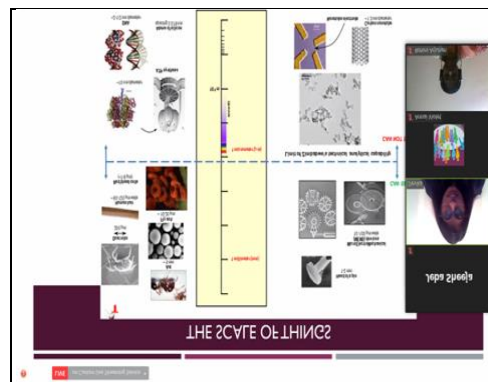

The aim of the conference was fulfilled; highly educative for the students and young researchers who wish to pursue research in bio chemicals.

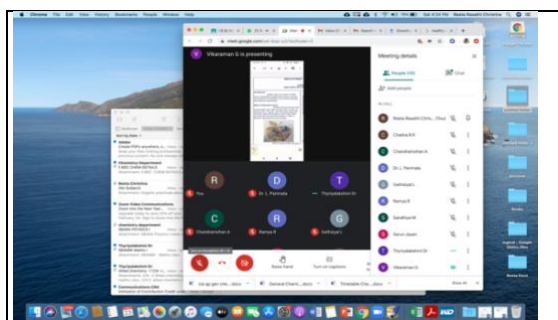
SEMINAR

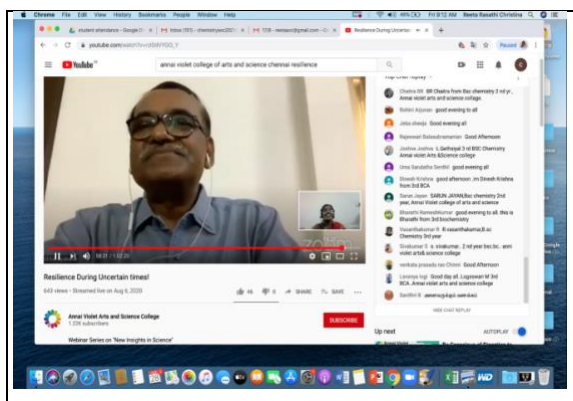
POSTER PRESENTATION

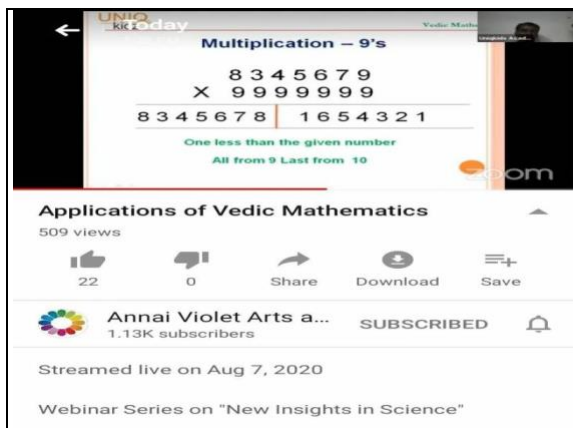

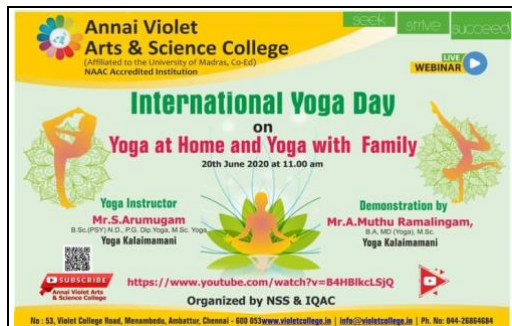
WORKSHOP

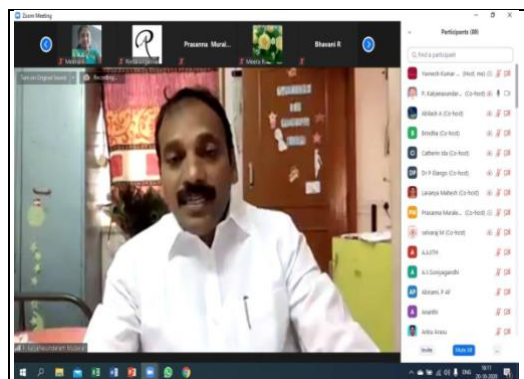


CITIZEN CONSUMER CLUB
