The fifth day provided principles of histopathology and the process of examining tissues microscopically to diagnose and study diseases. The sixth day covered the art of writing a proposal for funding and discussed various aspects of receiving a research grant from national and international funding agencies

The speaker in his lecture gave an idea of where the trained students will get their placements in various government and non-government sectors. Also, he motivated the students to start their own businesses with their innovative ideas and to get funding from various investors. He also briefed the audience on some of his current projects. The program creates awareness among the students about the preparation of many useful chemical products and various job opportunities after industrial training.

### **Extension activity on ‘Food Adulteration’**

On January 27th 2023, Department of Chemistry organized an extension activity about food adulteration in the neighboring school, Senthil Balaji Matriculation Higher Secondary School at Kallikuppam. Students of the department gave a demo on the identification of adulteration in milk, jaggery powder, asafetida, turmeric, chili powder, etc. The students came to know the techniques they should follow to check the quality of the products before they consume them. Also, our students interacted and clarified the doubts of the students and made them conscious about various preservatives added by the manufacturer to enhance the shelf-life of the product and to gain profit in the market. The activity creates awareness among the students about the preservatives and adulterants added by the product manufacturer as a marketing strategy to increase their profit.

### **Seminar on Nanostructures and Their Applications**

On 7th February 2022, the Department organized a seminar on Nanostructures and Their Applications. The program began with a prayer song, followed by the college choir. Welcome speech was presented by Rubinisri J of I B. Sc., Chemistry, followed by a guest introduction briefed by Dr. L. Parimala, Head Department of Chemistry. The resource person, Dr. J. 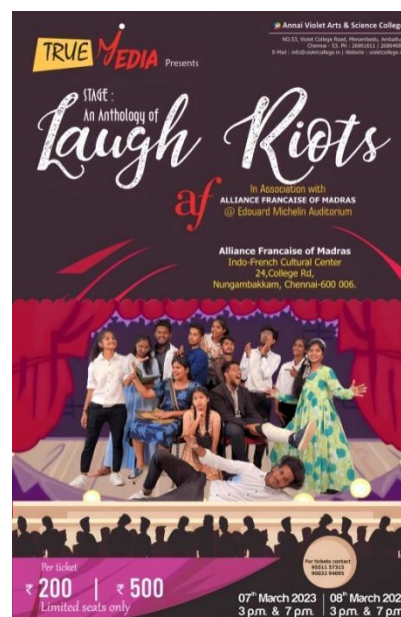

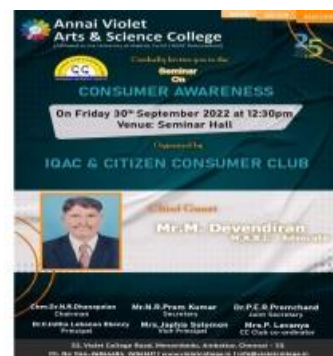
### Vio Alora 2022

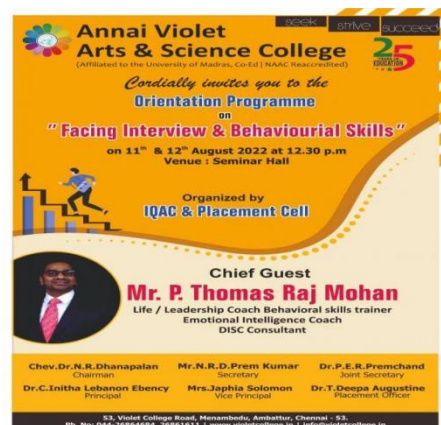
### **Entrepreneurship Skill – Attitude and Behaviour Development**

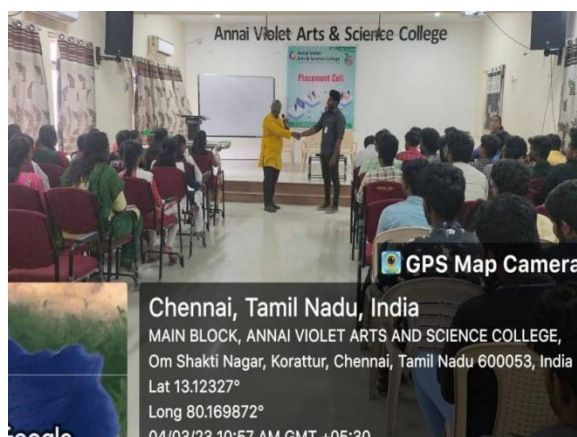


### **Workshop - Proficiency in Language for BPOs**

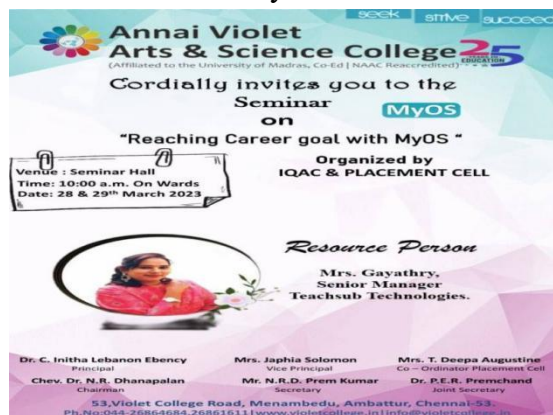
## Seminar on “Role of Aptitude and Reasoning in Competitive Exams”

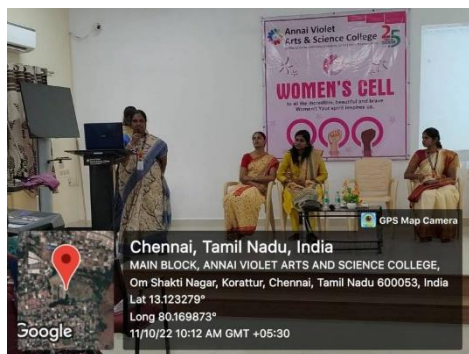
## WOMEN'S CELL

On 17<sup>th</sup> Feb 2023, 22 girls from Std X and XII were taken to Rehoboth Home for the Mentally Disabled, at Somangalam village, in Chengalpattu Dist. Around 80 women, mostly destitute, were lodged there. They were given treatment and Rehabilitation after identifying the skill set of the individual.



Exposure to regular occupational therapy and creative activities facilitates preserving their regained composure. Capable women were trained to make various custom-made, eco-friendly handicrafts. Mr. N. R. D. Birla was the chief guest. Mr. N. R. D. Premkumar, Secretary, Mrs. Lydia Devasagayam, Principal, Mrs. Sheeba Evangeline, the School Academic Supervisor and



Counselor, were also present. Annai Violet School girls spent time singing and interacting with them. They went around with them and saw the farms, garden, farm animals, pet birds and fishes. Rs. 22,000/- worth of fencing material [chain links] and garden hose pipe - giant size were donated to them, since that was the requirement that was asked by them. Mrs. Zoraida, the Director, had a brief session with the girls, about the techniques and methods adopted to rehabilitate the women and urged all the girls to be safe and strong.

## PROVIDING WHEELCHAIRS FOR PHYSICALLY CHALLENGED

Our Institution recognizes the importance of supporting individuals with physical disabilities, particularly those who rely on wheelchairs for mobility and independence, allowing them to participate in daily activities and access education and employment opportunities.
