### Opening:

The IQAC Meeting was called forth on 03/06/2022 and held at the Conference Hall. The meeting was called to order by the Chairperson, Dr. C. InithaLebononEbency and IQAC Coordinator and Vice Principal Mrs. Japhia Solomon.

### Summary:

- ✿ The meeting was crucial as the academic year marks the completion of 25 years in academics by the institution.
- ✿ In regard to this, 25 social mission projects were planned to execute in the forthcoming months. Each department was given a project to carry forward effectively as and when the project can be done.
- ✿ As some of the faculty withdrew from their service at the institution, certain changes and replacement of the previous members had been done by the IQAC Coordinator to carry out the plans for the year without any difficulty.
- ✿ Academic calendar was planned and laid out at the beginning of the meeting, taking in the points from the IQAC's Criterion Heads and Members.
- ✿ In view of the infrastructure, the management planned to build more classrooms on the other wing in the fourth floor. The classrooms may likely be used from the following semester or by the following academic year.
- ✿ To add further facilities in the department of Microbiology and for its research purposes, the additional necessary lab equipment were provided to facilitate the postgraduate scholars.
- ✿ Launching of Visual Communication department was discussed significantly. The coordinator and the management discussed on the technical needs for the department as well.
- ✿ Like the previous academic year, the Exam Cell was given the duty to conduct centralised Internal Examinations for UG and PG courses, following the schedule given in the College Calendar.
- ✿ The IQAC advised the departments to keep one FDP and one PDP programs compulsorily to grow and extend the academic association with the fellow institutions



and to instill the relevance of being updated. Conference, symposium, seminars, workshops, guest lecture sessions and department activities were also advised to conduct to create forums to students to learn beyond the wall.

- ✿ Recruitment of the faculty to the required streams was discussed with reference to the workload with the concern department head.
- ✿ To encourage the faculty community to participate in various academic programs, remuneration was decided to be paid off to the individuals with the submission of necessary documents and bills.
- ✿ The management, jointly with Lion's Club, decided to honour the excellence of some of the teachers' service and sincerity by holding an award ceremony at some point in the academic year.
- ✿ Salary was decided to be revised with reference to the self-appraisal form filled in by each faculty at the end of the previous academic year.
- ✿ The meeting concluded with a positive note on bringing forth many more achievements and successful completion of the mission projects, academic and non-academic programs in the following months by the IQAC Cell.




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## IQAC MEETING MINUTES IV EVEN SEMESTER – (2022 – 23) 29<sup>th</sup> April 2023


### Summary:


